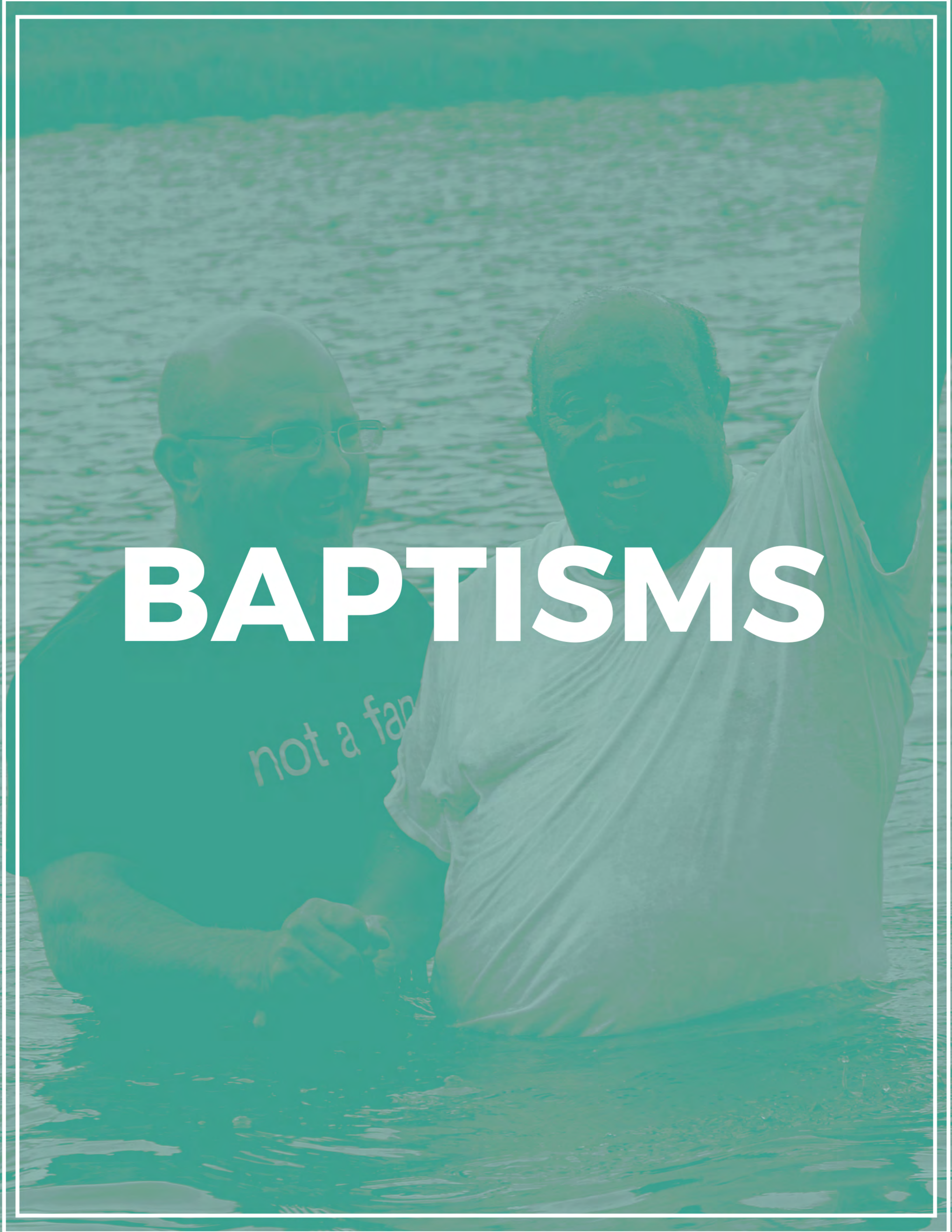

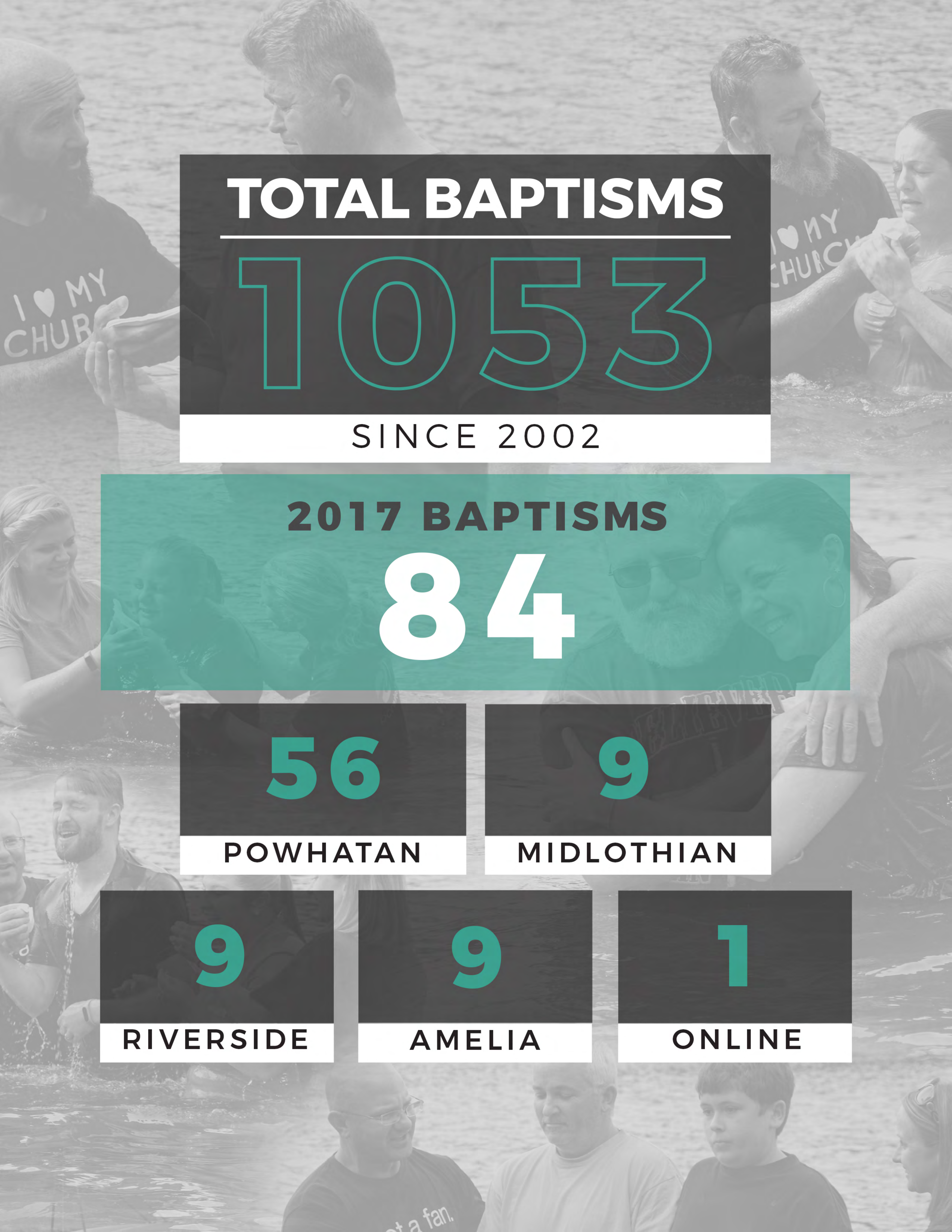

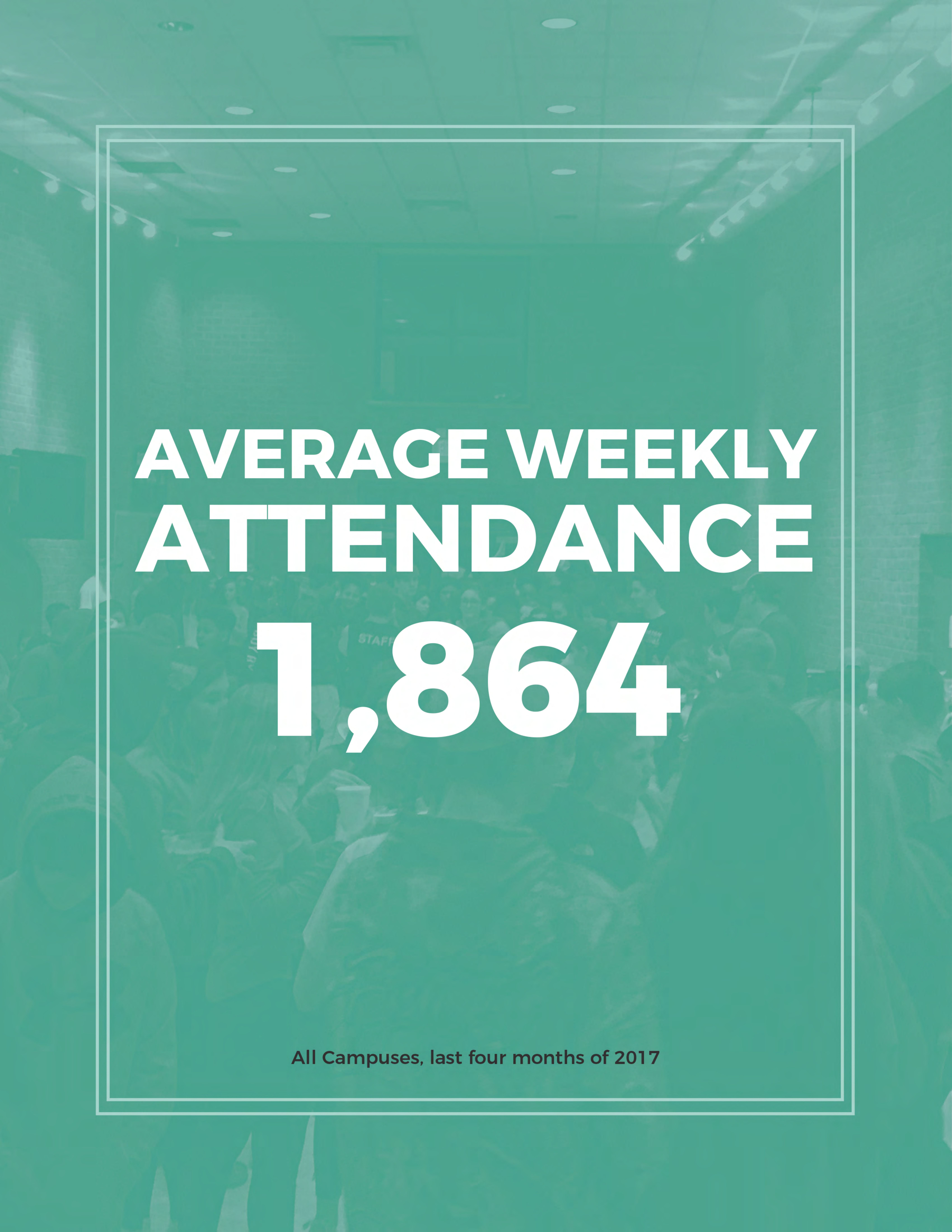

ATTENDANCE**

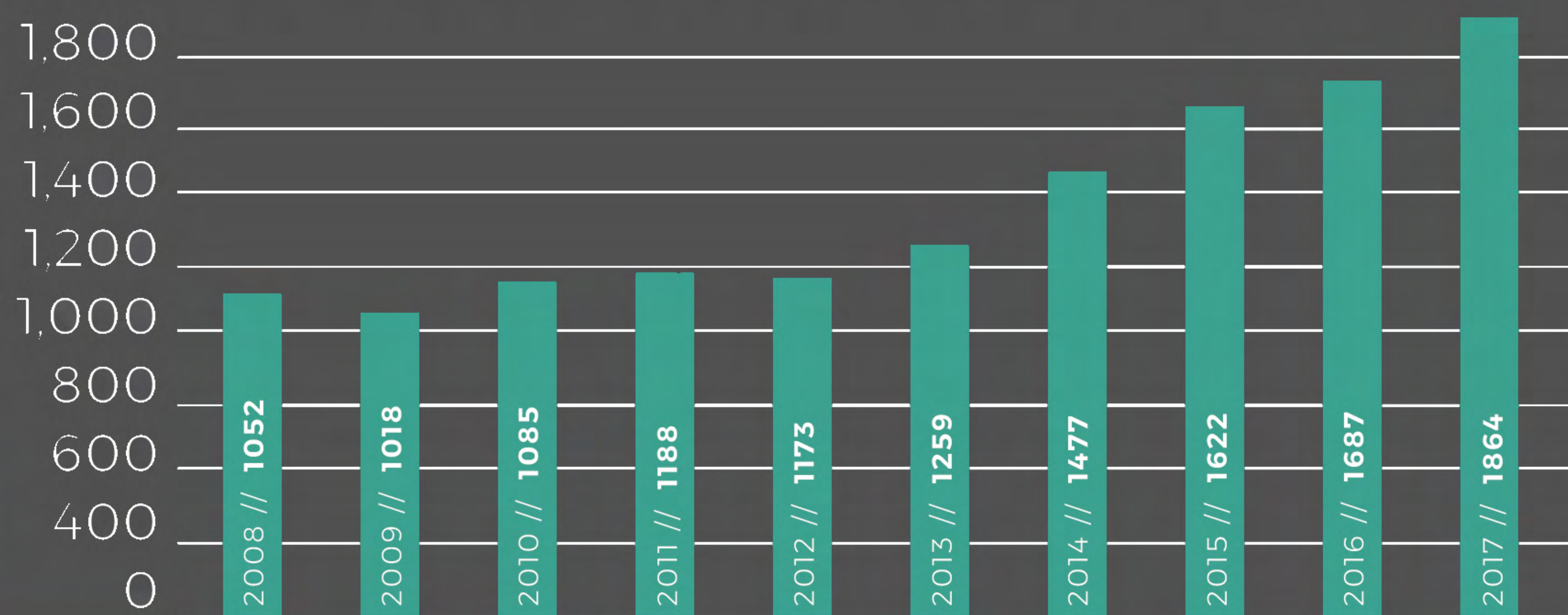

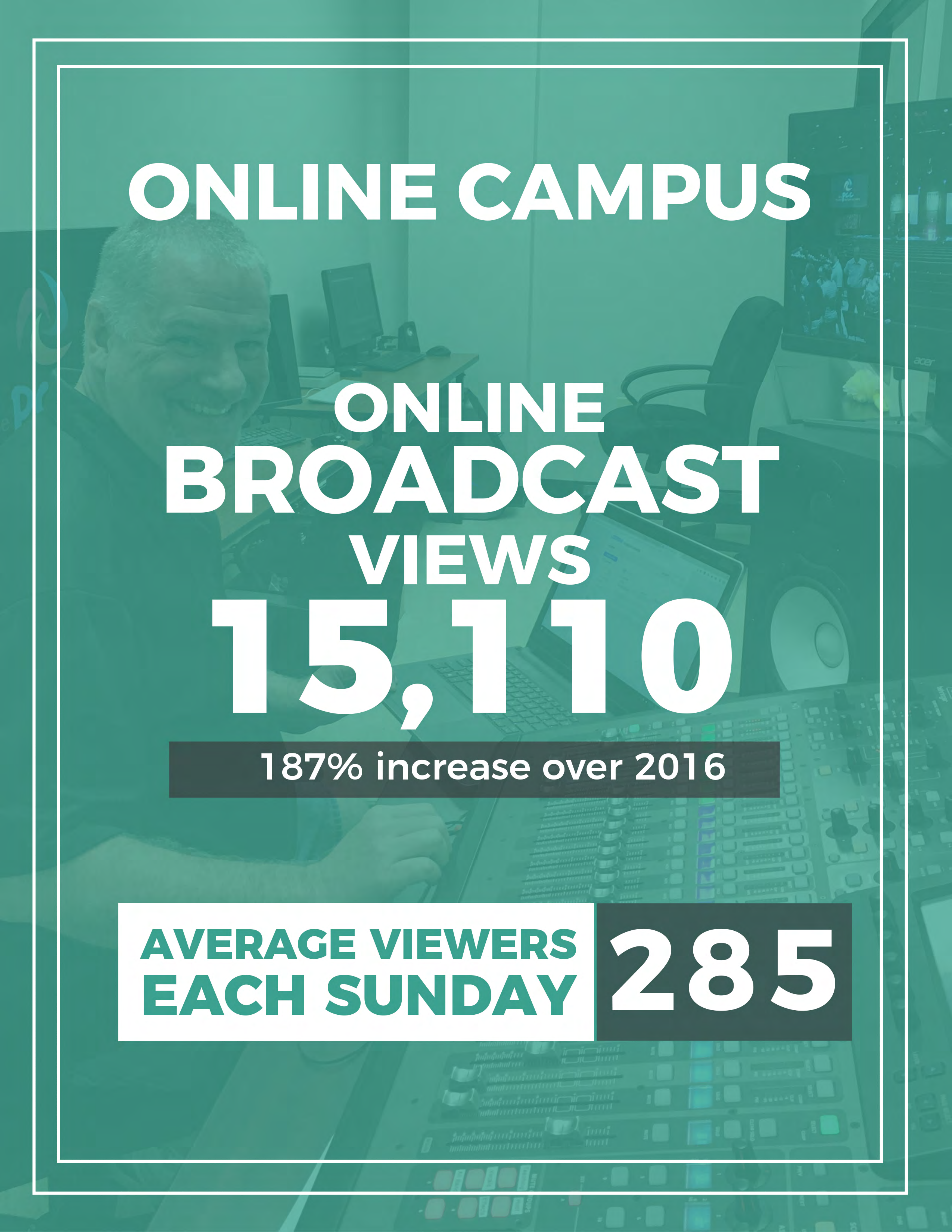

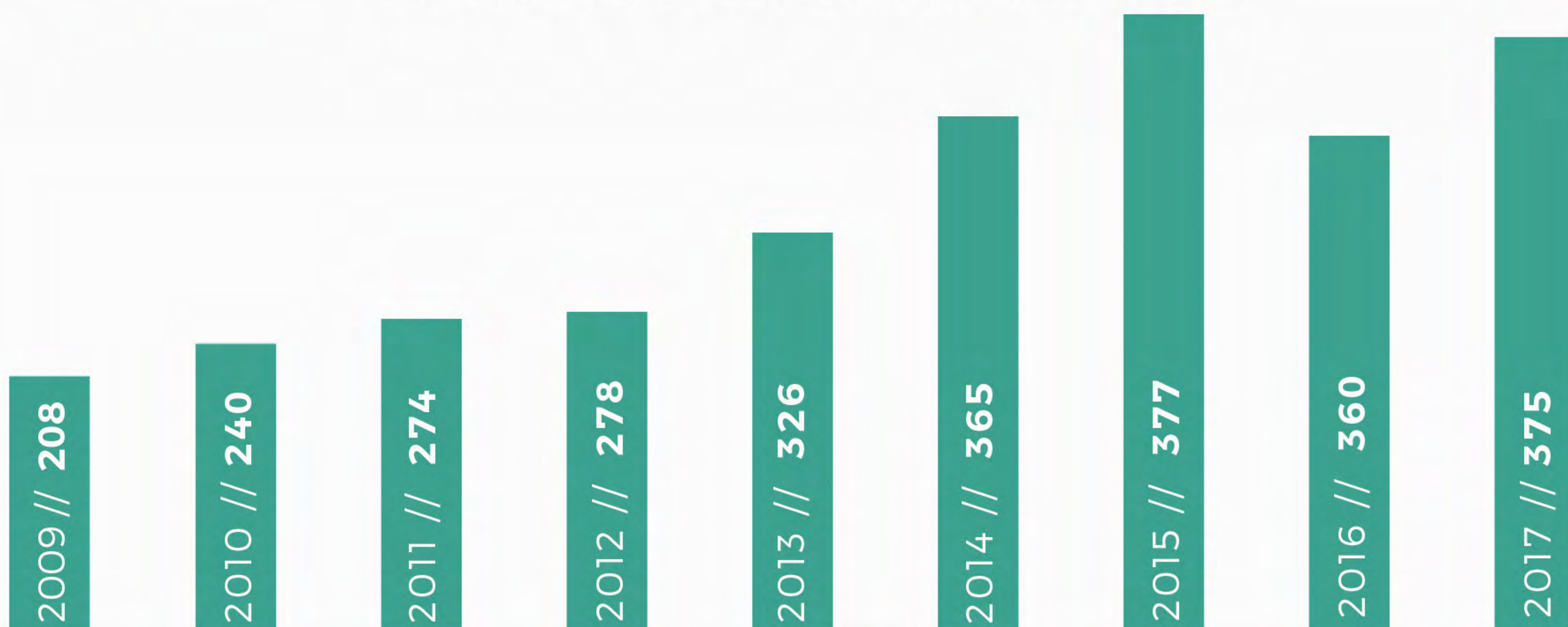

DOING GOOD INTERNATIONALLY

BELIZE

Our Belize Mission Team continued to support Calvary Baptist Church in Belize by providing basic utilities and Sunday School supplies. They also provided funding for the Calvary Baptist Youth Center, as well as feeding people in the local community. The 14 members of the team provided support for seven children to go to school and helped several Calvary church members with food and utilities.

MOLDOVA

PCC strengthened its partnership with Justice and Mercy International (JMI) to provide care and support for 50 high school and college age orphans. We also provided emergency placements for 8 youths transitioning out of orphanages and in need of sponsors. In addition, PCC launched a jobs development initiative and began working with a local church, Jesus the Good Shepherd, helping them reach out to poor villages.

TANZANIA

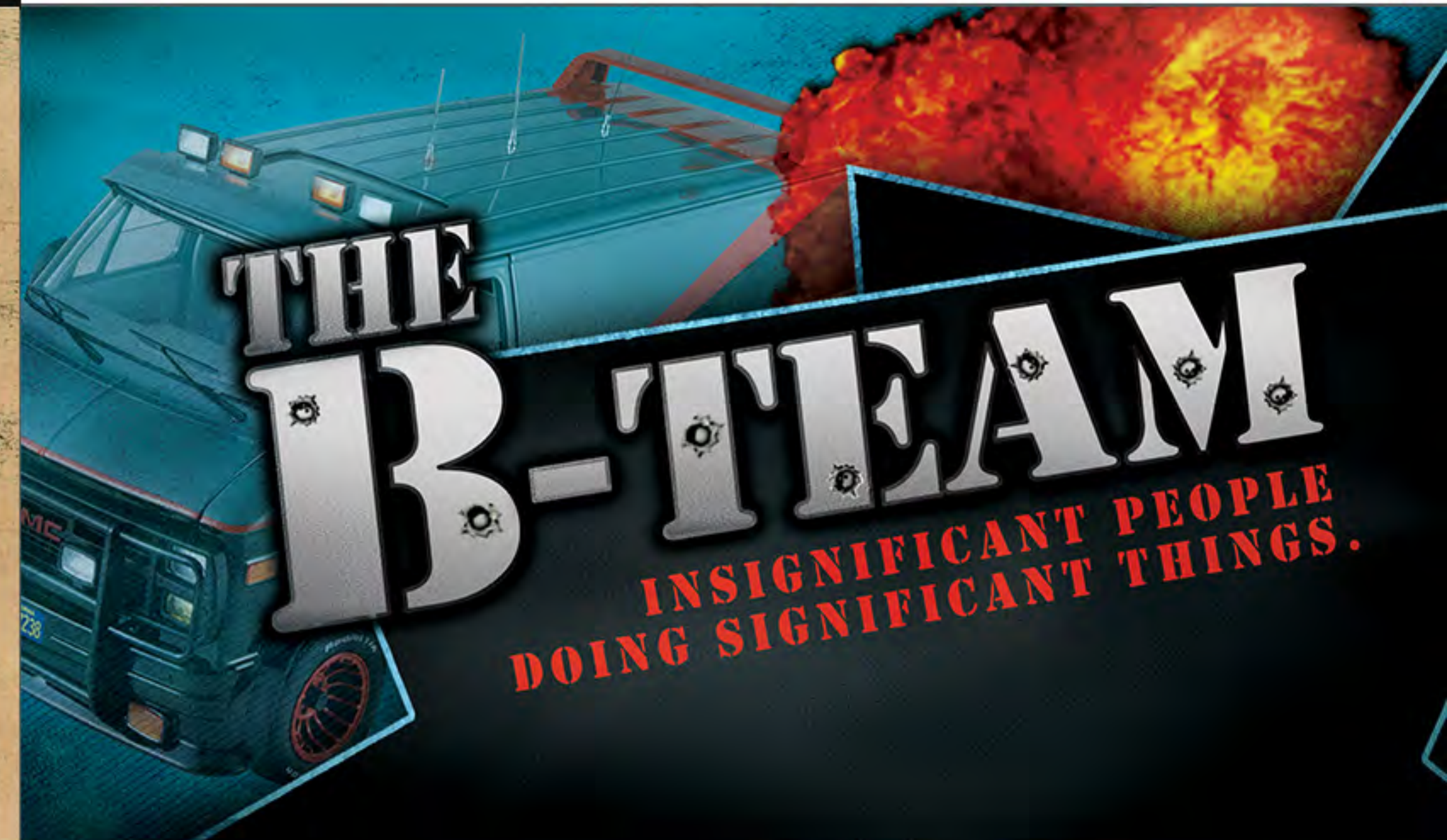

PCC attendees packed 981 Operation Christmas Child Boxes for kids abroad through 'Do Good'.

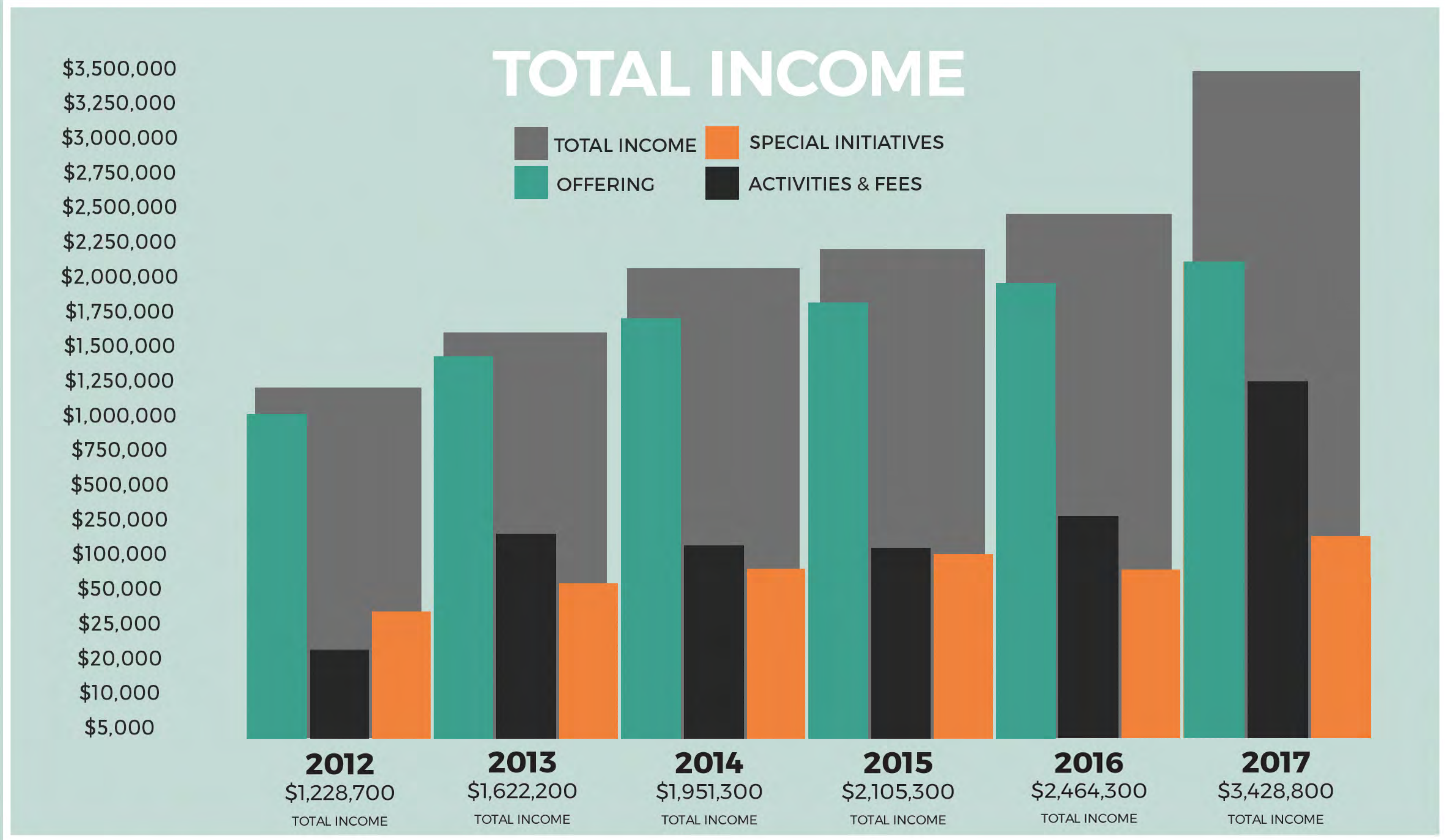

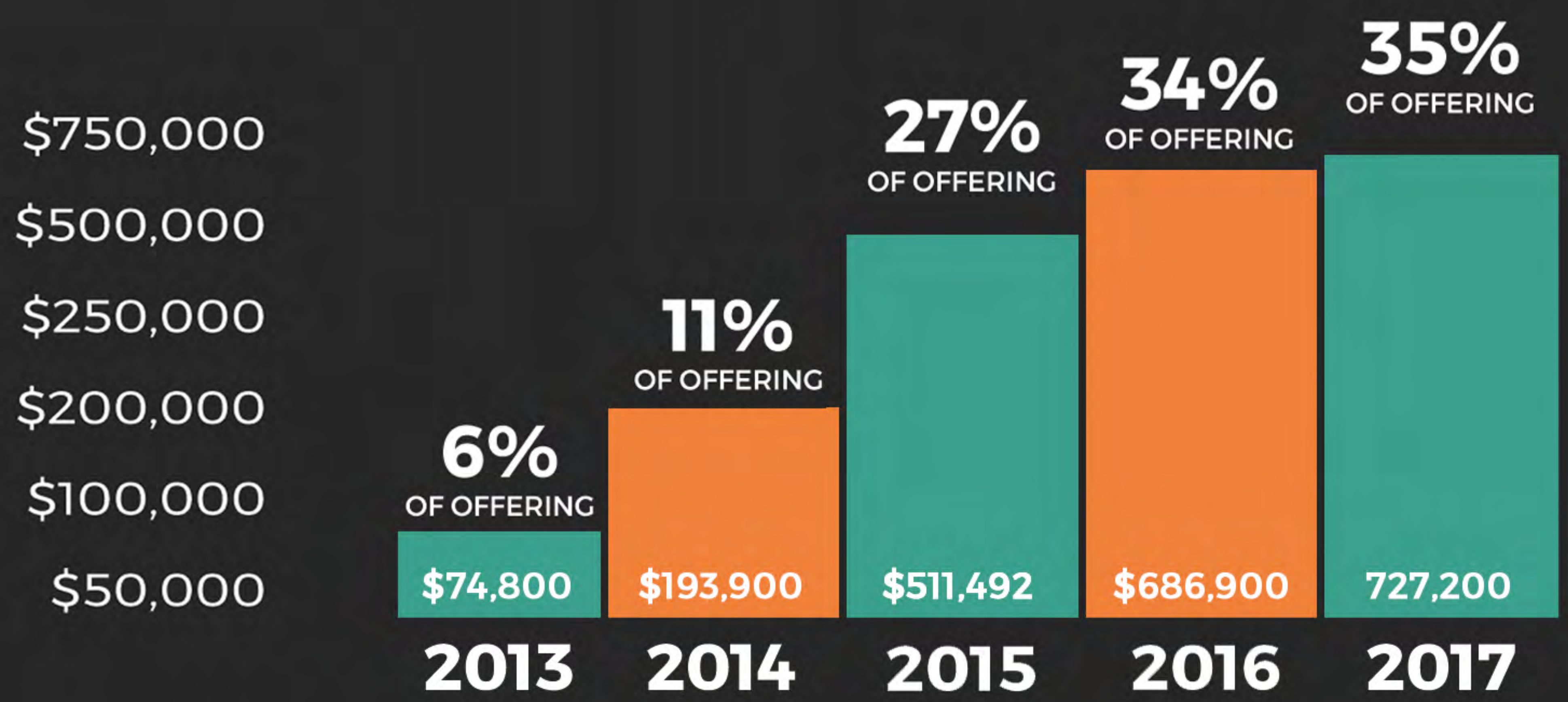

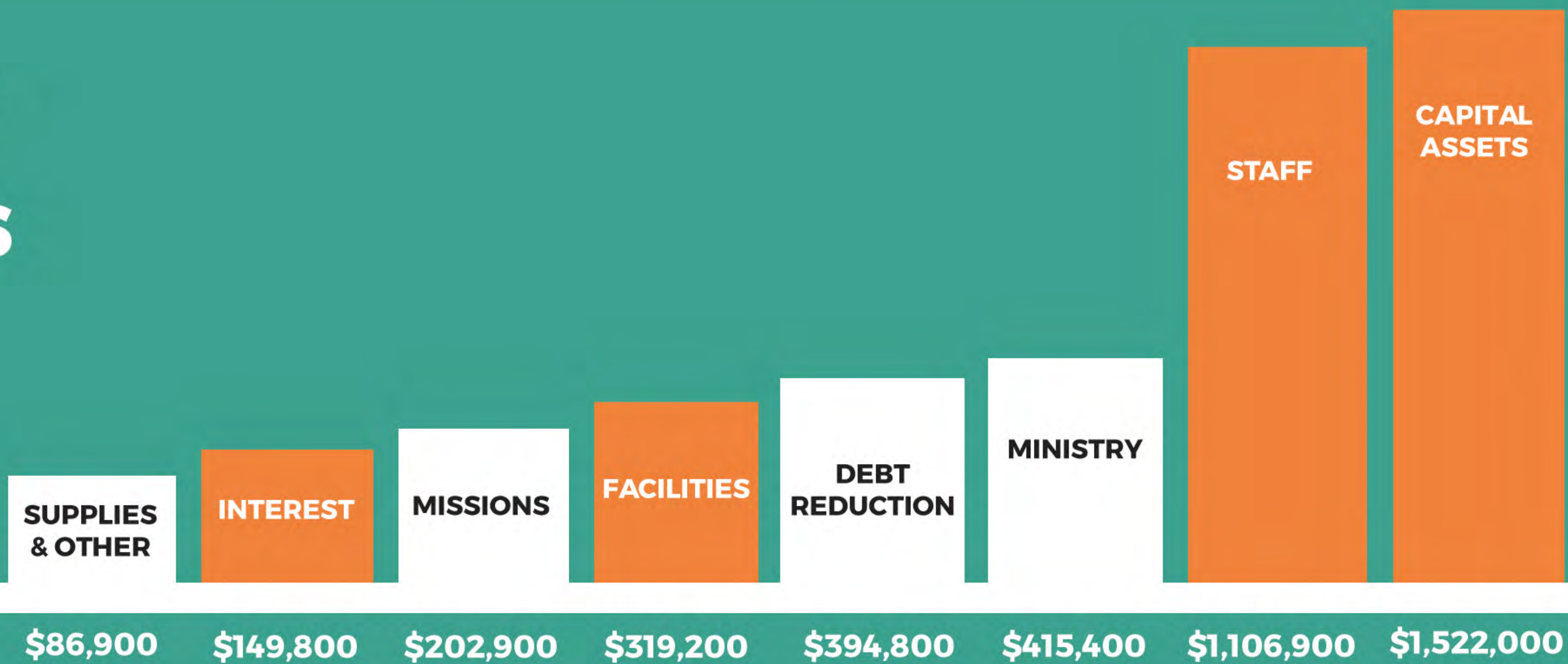
