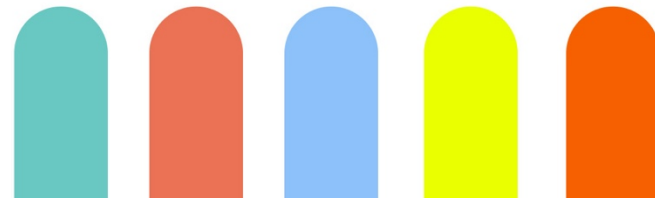
You can pray:

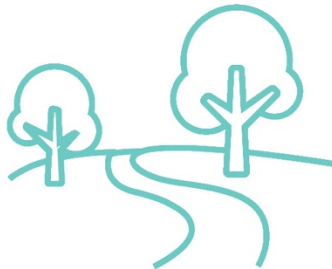
3. Plan

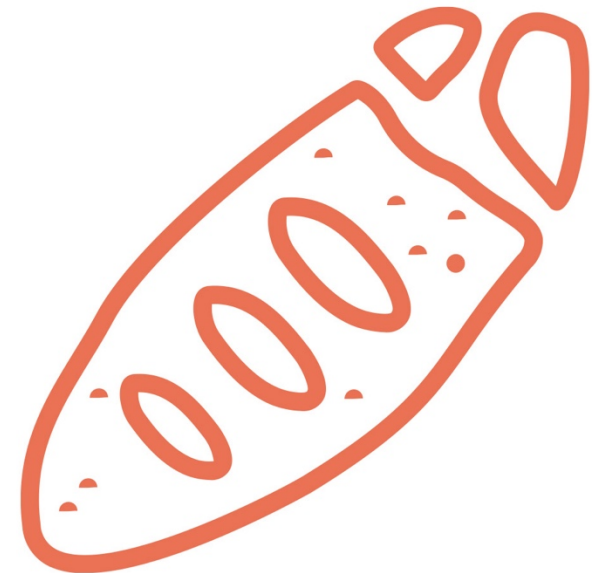

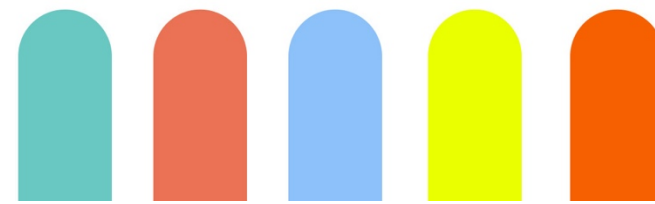

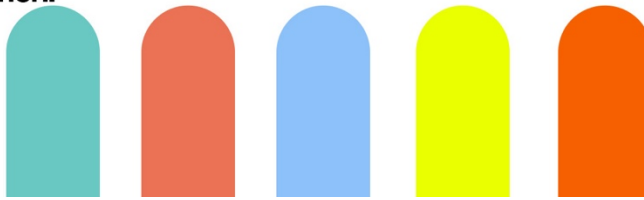

Color in the numbers 1-5 and draw lines on the road map on the next page as you ask Jesus to lead you today!

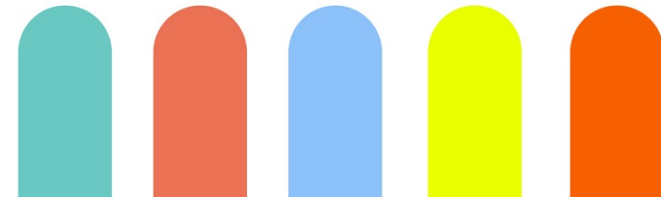
1. Thank You, Jesus, for the plan You have for me!

PRAYERS FOR WHEN I NEED HELP

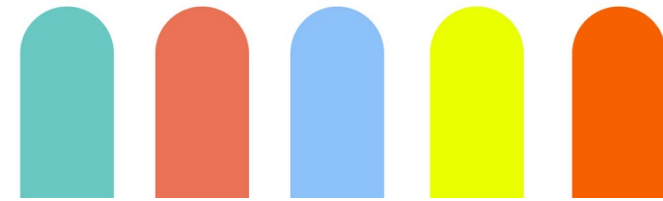
Pray through the Armor of God

PRAYERS THROUGH THE ARMOR OF GOD



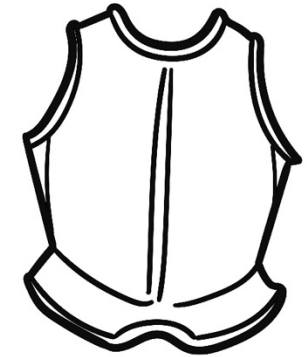
Coloring Activity

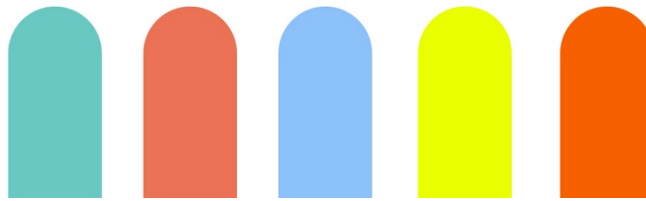

I pray You would give (say their names) and me wisdom today to make good choices and do the things You would want us to do.

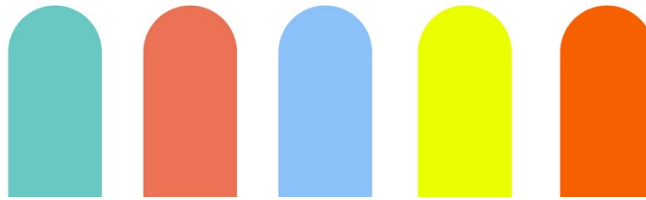
I pray that You will bless us so that we can be a blessing to others.

Thank You that You never leave me, and that I never have to feel alone.

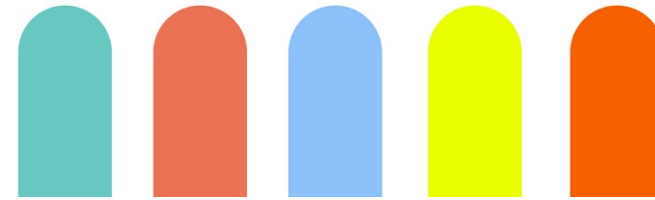
As You are with me today, help me follow You and make good choices.

me by Your name.

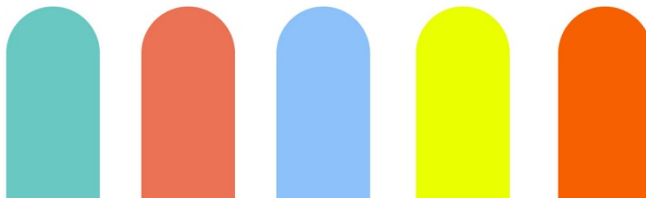
I ask that you would give me peace, perfect love that

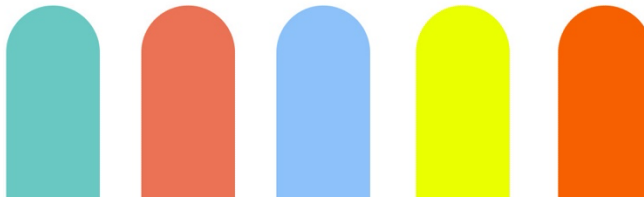
